Every resident has now this handy **reusable, washable Recycling Bag,** compliments of the City of Dublin. We've also added new recycling signs in the trash rooms and provided you with a HOW TO GUIDE to help answer your recycling questions. Please take a moment to review the GUIDE (located inside your recycling bag) and the easy reference instructions printed on the bag itself.

IMPORTANT! Recycling & Trash Area Changes

- RECYCLING CHUTES The chutes marked "Recycling" are for clean dry paper, empty bottles and cans, and <u>small</u> (flattened) cardboard boxes only. <u>LOOSE</u> <u>RECYCLABLES ONLY</u> (no plastic bags accepted). All garbage goes in the chutes marked "trash". No large cardboard boxes.
- CARDBOARD ONLY RECYCLING DUMPSTERS Large cardboard boxes can be recycled in one of the _____ white dumpsters located in the garage (see site map). No bottles and cans, paper or trash in the white dumpsters. ALL BOXES MUST BE FLATTENED.
- **RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS** Look for the Mixed Recycling signs and decals with the **gold arrow**, like the one printed on your recycling bag.
- GROUND FLOOR RESIDENTS Ground floor residents will continue to use the white Cardboard Only and Mixed Recycling bins for recycling and the green dumpsters for <u>trash</u>.
