## 3 EASY STEPS TO OBTAIN YOUR BINS

- 1** Complete the online form at: [www.RecyclingRulesAC.org/containers](http://www.RecyclingRulesAC.org/containers)  
You do not need to know exactly what you wish to order at this stage.
- 2** Ordering instructions will be provided once your submission is approved.  
Expect a response within 1-2 weeks of submitting your application.
- 3** Select your equipment and place your order with one vendor.  
Review the container and lid options offered by our 3 partner vendors, then select one vendor and place an order up to \$500 including tax and delivery. Equipment will be delivered to your site in 2-4 weeks.



**Multi-family property owners/managers:** Kitchen pails for residents are available free of charge in most cities. Contact your service provider to request pails for in-unit use, and apply for the \$500 ACWMA allocation if containers are needed for common areas.
